

Elks Scholarships Available to 2017 High School Graduating Seniors

Graduating high school seniors can receive scholarships through the Elks five different ways.

1. Legacy Scholarships – This is available to children or grandchildren of Elks that will have maintained membership for at least a year as of April 1, 2017. Three scholarships will be presented in Georgia by the Elks National Foundation. They will be eligible to receive \$1,000 per year for four years. 2. Emergency Education Grants – This provides undergraduate college financial assistance to children of deceased or totally disabled Elks in the form of renewable, one-year grants of up to \$4,000. 3. Most Valuable Student Scholarships - Students who apply for this scholarship are eligible to receive awards from three sources. The Elks National Foundation will award \$2,440,000 in college scholarships this year to 500 high school graduating seniors through this contest. Applications and information is available at enf.elks.org/mvs.
4. Georgia Elks Scholarships - These are presented to applicants with the highest scores on the district level.
5. Dalton Elks Local Scholarships - Ten local high school seniors will receive \$500 each directly from our lodge. These will be selected from those who apply for the Most Valuable Student Scholarships.
